Dress Code Handbook

NHCC Dress Code & Policies

“Relaxed” Event Dress Code

In order to ensure a consistent and enjoyable experience for all Members and guests at North Hempstead Country Club, we have a set of standards we hold each other to. The following information will help advise both Members and guests of our views (and your responsibilities) as it relates to attire.

Dress Code

Men and boys: Jeans (no holes, tears or frays) are permitted throughout the entire clubhouse at all times Tuesday-Friday. Jeans are prohibited Saturday, Sunday, Monday and specified holidays. Cargo pants, cargo shorts, short-sleeve mock turtleneck golf shirts, swim attire, tank tops and cut-offs of any type are prohibited throughout the clubhouse and patio. T-shirts, gym shorts, lacrosse shorts, sandals and flip-flops may be worn in the locker room, exercise room and pool area. Hats must be removed when entering the clubhouse.

Women and girls: Jeans (no holes, tears or frays) are permitted throughout the entire clubhouse at all times Tuesday-Friday. Jeans (except white jeans) are prohibited Saturday, Sunday, Monday and specified holidays. Cargo pants, cargo shorts, yoga pants, tube tops, bare midriffs, swim attire, see-through clothes and cut-offs of any type are prohibited throughout the clubhouse and patio. T-shirts, tank tops (sleeveless, collarless made of t-shirt material), gym shorts and lacrosse shorts may be worn in the locker room, exercise room and pool area.

It is every member's responsibility to ensure their family members and guests adhere to the dress code. Members should make every effort to immediately rectify any violations. Management has been instructed to discreetly notify of infractions as to avoid any embarrassment of members or their guests.

Main Dining Room, Main Bar, Grill Room, Peacock Alley, and Patio

The following minimum levels of acceptable attire have been defined for the clubhouse and its dining and lounge areas:

Main Dining Room & Main Bar: Jackets are required on Saturday evenings only. All other times after 6pm a club casual dress code is required. Club casual dress code for men does require slacks, collared shirts, & closed shoes and appropriate dress for ladies for dining in the main dining room. Golf shorts are prohibited in the main dining room or main bar, unless the main bar is the only one open.

Grill Room, Peacock Alley, and Patio: Golf casual and/or club casual dress code

Golf casual and/or club casual attire includes collared shirts, shorts or long pants. Oversized casual clothing is prohibited. No excessively baggy trousers or shirts, cargo pants, crocs or flip-flops. Women are permitted to wear sandals. Men's shirts are to be tucked in. Un-tucked shirts are permitted only in the pool area or tennis courts (except on specified days/events).



When untucked Tommy Bahama & untucked hemmed shirts are permitted



Regular button down shirts, polos & golf shirts are not to be untucked

Shirts must have a collar

Untucked Shirts for Specified Events

- Button down shirts with a contoured hemline that are meant to be worn untucked (i.e. UNTUCKit shirts or Tommy Bahama shirts) are permitted for predetermined events
- T-shirts and sports jerseys are prohibited. Golf shirts & polos must be tucked in
- Dress codes will be included on event flyers and on the website

Jean Dress Code



When jeans are permitted Tuesday - Friday



Ripped jeans are prohibited

Shirts must be tucked in

Jeans

- Jeans in all colors are permitted Tuesday - Friday for men & women unless otherwise specified on event flyer. No holes, tears or frays
- Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in for men
- White jeans are always permitted for women
No holes, tears or frays

Golf Course and Practice Area: Shoes are to be changed in the locker room. Long-sleeve turtle-necks and long-sleeve mock turtle-necks are permitted after closing day and before opening day, as well as in inclement weather conditions during the golf season.

Men: Golf shirt with collar and sleeves, golf slacks or Bermuda type golf length shorts not more than 2" above the knee are acceptable. Shirts must be tucked in. Jeans, tennis designed attire and swimming attire are prohibited. Hats must be worn with visor forward. Short-sleeve mock turtle-neck golf shirts, blade collars and T-shirts are prohibited.

Women: Golf skirts and golf shorts not more than 6" above the knee are acceptable. Golf shorts and slacks will have a relaxed fit around the legs. Golf shirts may be worn with or without a collar. Sleeveless shirts must have a collar while collarless shirts must have sleeves. Golf shirts must be tucked in at all times unless they are designed to be worn untucked. Bare midriffs are prohibited.

Juniors: All juniors must conform to the dress code. College and school logos are acceptable on collared shirts when playing golf. Sweaters must be worn over a collared shirt. Attire with offensive messages and/or graphics is unacceptable. Hats must be worn with visor forward.

Tennis Courts: Predominantly white tennis designed attire is required. Jeans, street shorts, lacrosse, and other sports outfits are prohibited.

Children age 14 and younger may wear predominantly white tennis designed attire and are permitted to wear t-shirts.

Only tennis sneakers approved for soft court surfaces may be worn.

Proper tennis outfits may be worn on the clubhouse patio, but please note that children in t-shirts are not allowed in this area as well as men in collarless tennis shirts.

Swimming Pool Area: The pool prohibits jeans with holes, tears and frays, cargo shorts and cut-offs. Proper and modest bathing suits are required for use of the pool. **Gym and lacrosse shorts are not to be used as bathing suits.**

Bathing suits should not be worn in areas outside of the pool facility. Shirts or cover-ups must be worn when arriving at and leaving the pool. Wearing towels outside the pool area is prohibited.

Golf shoes are prohibited on the pool deck.

Men's Golf Course & Practice Area Dress Code



Golf shorts no more than 2" above knee



Golf slacks are permitted



Cargo pants & shorts are prohibited



Hat must have visor forward



Shirts must have collars & be tucked-in



Mock short sleeve turtlenecks are prohibited



Shirts must be tucked-in



Blade collars are prohibited

- Shoes are to be changed in the locker room
- Acceptable attire includes golf shirts with a collar and sleeves, golf slacks or Bermuda type golf length shorts not more than 2" above the knee
- Shirts are to be tucked in
- Jeans in all colors, tennis attire and swimming attire are prohibited on the golf course
- Hats must be worn visor forward
- Short-sleeve mock turtleneck golf shirts, blade collars and T-shirts are prohibited
- Cargo shorts are prohibited

Women's Clubhouse Dress Code



Shorts are permitted



Dress pants are permitted



White jeans are permitted



Jeans are permitted Tuesday- Friday only



Jeans with holes, tears or frays are prohibited



Strapless dresses are permitted



Tube tops are prohibited



Bare midriffs are prohibited



Cargo pants are prohibited



Yoga pants are prohibited



Sandals are permitted



Casual flip-flops are prohibited

- Jeans (no holes, tears or frays) are permitted Tuesday - Friday all day
- Jeans (except white) are prohibited Saturday, Sunday, Monday and specified holidays
- Cargo pants, cargo shorts, bare midriffs, swim attire, see-through clothes, and cut-offs of any type are prohibited
- White jean pants, shorts, skirts and jackets without holes, tears or frays may be worn only by women year round. Cut-offs are prohibited
- Tight fitting tube tops are prohibited. Strapless dresses are permitted
- Sandals are permitted for women. Casual flip-flops such as foam or pool & beach flip flops are prohibited
- Athletic wear is prohibited, including, yoga pants, shirts made of t-shirt material, sweatpants and sweatshirts outside of the locker room and fitness center

Men's Clubhouse Dress Code



Dress pants or Khakis are permitted



Jeans are permitted Tuesday- Friday only



Cargo pants are prohibited



Cargo shorts are prohibited



Shirts must have collars & be tucked-in



Shirts must be tucked-in



T-shirts are prohibited



Closed toe shoes are permitted



Flip-flops of any kind and crocs are prohibited



- Jeans (no holes, tears or frays) are permitted Tuesday - Friday all day
- Jeans are prohibited Saturday, Sunday, Monday and specified holidays
- Cargo pants, cargo shorts, short-sleeve mock turtle neck golf shirts, swim attire, tank tops and cut-offs of any type are prohibited
- Oversized casual clothing is prohibited. No excessively baggy trousers or shirts. No crocs, flip-flops or sandals
- Shirts are to be tucked in (except on specified days/events)
- Hats are to be removed when entering the clubhouse
- Athletic wear is prohibited outside of the locker room and fitness center
- Jackets are required in the main dining room and main bar Saturday evenings after 6pm (and on specified days/events)

Women's Golf Course & Practice Area Dress Code



Golf shorts & skirts may be no more than 6" above knee

Shorts & slacks must have relaxed fit



Shirts must be tucked in unless designed to be untucked



Sleeveless shirts must have a collar



Collarless shirts must have long sleeves



Tank tops are prohibited

- Shoes are to be changed in the locker room
- Acceptable attire includes golf skirts and golf shorts not more than 6" above the knee
- Golf shorts and slacks will have a relaxed fit around the legs
- Golf shirts may be worn with or without a collar. Sleeveless shirts must have a collar while collarless shirts must have long sleeves
- Golf shirts must be tucked in at all times unless they are designed to be worn untucked
- Tank tops and bare midriffs are prohibited
- Jeans in all colors, tennis attire, and swimming attire are prohibited on the golf course

Pool Dress Code



Modest bathing suits are required



Board shorts are permitted



Jeans are permitted for men & women



Cut-off shirts are prohibited



Gym & lacrosse shorts are prohibited in the pool



Cargo shorts are prohibited



Jeans with holes, tears or frays are prohibited

Tennis Dress Code



Predominantly white tennis attire is required



Children 14 & younger must wear predominantly white clothing



Predominantly white tennis attire is required

Pool

- Jeans are permitted at the pool at all times. No holes, tears or frays
- Cargo shorts, cut-off shorts and cut-off sleeve shirts are prohibited
- Proper and modest bathing suits are required for use of the pool
- **Gym & lacrosse shorts can be worn to the pool but can not be used as bathing suits**
- Shirts and cover-ups must be worn when arriving at and leaving the pool
- Bathing suits are not to be worn in areas outside of the pool facility
- Wearing towels outside the pool area is prohibited
- Golf shoes are prohibited on the pool deck

Tennis

- Predominantly white tennis attire is required
- Jeans, street shorts, lacrosse shorts and other sports outfits are prohibited
- Only tennis sneakers approved for soft court surfaces may be worn
- Children age 14 & younger must wear predominantly white and t-shirts are permitted
- Proper tennis outfits may be worn on the clubhouse patio, but please note that children in t-shirts are not allowed in this area as well as men in collarless tennis shirts
